1 Introduction

1.1 Exponential IT Solutions CC, registration number 1998/040919/23, operating as Exponential IT Solutions] ("we," "us," or "our"), complies with the Protection of Personal Information Act No. 4 of 2013 (POPIA) and other applicable data protection laws. This policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and protect your personal information.

2 What Personal Information We Collect

We may collect:

- 2.1 Identifiers: Name, ID number, passport number.
- 2.2 Contact Details: Email, phone number, physical address.
- 2.3 Demographic Data: Age, gender, language preferences.
- 2.4 Financial Data: Bank details, payment history (if applicable).
- 2.5 Online Data: IP address, device information, cookies, browsing behaviour.
- 2.6 Sensitive Data: Race, health information (only with explicit consent or legal justification).

3 How we collect information

- 3.1 Directly: When you contact us, use our services, register on our website, or subscribe to newsletters.
- 3.2 Automatically: Via cookies, server logs, and analytics tools when you visit our website.
- 3.3 Third Parties: From partners, public databases, or social media (where legally permitted).

4 Purposes for Processing Personal Information

We use your data to:

- 4.1 Provide and improve our products/services.
- 4.2 Process payments and fulfill contracts.



- 4.3 Communicate with you (e.g., support, updates).
- 4.4 Comply with legal obligations (e.g., tax, POPIA).
- 4.5 Send marketing communications (with your consent).
- 4.6 Protect against fraud and security risks.

5 Lawful Basis for Processing

We process personal information based on:

- 5.1 Your consent (e.g., for marketing).
- 5.2 Contractual necessity (e.g., to deliver services).
- 5.3 Legal obligations (e.g., record-keeping under tax laws).
- 5.4 Legitimate interests (e.g., improving our website).

6 Sharing of Personal Information

We may share data with:

- 6.1 Service Providers: Payment processors, IT support, cloud storage providers.
- 6.2 Legal Authorities: Where required by law (e.g., court orders).
- 6.3 Business Partners: With your consent (e.g., joint promotions).

7 Cross-Border Transfers

- 7.1 Obtain your consent if required by POPIA.
- 7.2 Ensure recipients are subject to adequate data protection laws.

8 Data Security

We implement technical and organizational measures to protect personal information, including:



- 8.1 Encryption, firewalls, and access controls.
- 8.2 Regular security audits.
- 8.3 Employee training on POPIA compliance.

9 Data Retention

We retain personal information:

- 9.1 Only as long as necessary for the purposes stated.
- 9.2 As required by law (e.g., financial records for 5 years).
- 9.3 Securely delete/anonymize data afterward.

10 Your Rights Under POPIA

You have the right to:

- 10.1 Access your personal information.
- 10.2 Correct inaccurate or incomplete data.
- 10.3 Delete data (where no legal basis for retention exists).
- 10.4 Object to processing for direct marketing.
- 10.5 Withdraw consent (where processing is consent-based).
